



## 2019 World Jamboree - US Contingent

### Adult Troop/Crew Leader Qualifications

Before applying, please review the selection criteria. We anticipate numerous applicants; if you do not meet most of the criteria, please do not apply.



### Adult leader Qualifications in the BSA contingent:

#### Unit Leader (Troop or Crew)

- Must be at least 21 years of age by July 22, 2019.
- Serve as a Scoutmaster, Assistant Scoutmaster, Advisor, or Associate Advisor for at least one year during the three-year period prior to July 1, 2019.
- Complete basic Scoutmaster and Assistant Scoutmaster Leadership Specific Training.
- All leaders are required to have a medical exam and submit the BSA's required Annual Health and Medical Record (AHMR).
- Complete Youth Protection Training within one year of your arrival date at the 2019 World Scout Jamboree site.
- Be approved by the local council and appropriate region.
- Wood Badge and Scouter's Key are desirable qualifications, although not required.

#### First Assistant Leader

Same qualifications as Scoutmaster are required.

#### Second Assistant Leader

- Be at least 21 years of age by July 22, 2019.
- Complete the appropriate leader-specific training.
- Serve actively in an adult troop leadership position for at least one year during the three-year period prior to July 1, 2019.
- All leaders are required to have a medical exam and submit the BSA's required Annual Health and Medical Record (AHMR).
- Complete Youth Protection Training within one year of your arrival date at the 2019 World Scout Jamboree site.
- Be approved by the local council and appropriate region.

#### Third Assistant Leader

- Be at least 18 years of age (but not yet 21) by July 22, 2019.
- Serve actively in a unit leadership position.
- Complete the appropriate leader-specific training.
- All leaders are required to have a medical exam and submit the BSA's required Annual Health and Medical Record (AHMR).
- Complete Youth Protection Training within one year of your arrival date at the 2019 World Scout Jamboree site.
- Be approved by the local council and appropriate region.
