## World Jamboree 2019

The USA Contingent to the 24th World Scout Jamboree in 2019 application process is open.

The United States Contingent is limited on the number of people that we can send to a World Scout Jamboree. While we will be able to send more to this Jamboree than ever before, we expect there to be tremendous interest and encourage folks to apply as soon as possible.

Dates: July 22 – August 2, 2019 (USA Contingent will arrive on July 21, 2019)

Location: Summit Bechtel Scout Reserve, West Virginia, USA

Eligibility: Birthday between July 22, 2001 and July 21, 2005

Youth participants (boys and girls) must be age 14-17 Registered Boy Scouts, Ventures, Explorers may apply.

Adult unit leaders: Birthday before July 22, 2001 (age 18 and older) Selection in March 2018. International Service Team (IST) age 18 and older.

### **Application Process:**

Participants, adult leaders, and IST will complete an online application. Applications will be reviewed on both a Council and National level. Official information and a link to the online application can be found on the USA Contingent website: <a href="https://wsj2019.us/apply">https://wsj2019.us/apply</a>. Adult Leaders and IST must be approved by the Last Frontier Council.

Fees: LFC Contingent Cost \$2,500 plus expenses.

International Service Team (IST). Southern Region fee is \$1,800 plus expenses.

### Selection Process:

The Boy Scouts of America is limited to the number of participants and International Service Team Members it can send to a World Jamboree. Based on anticipated participation, space is limited. Youth who will be eligible, but are currently not age eligible need to contact Don Carter for the process to apply.

### Visitor Opportunity:

Last Frontier Council has approved the development of a contingent to travel to and from the Jamboree Site to attend as Visitors. If there is enough interest planning will begin in 2018 with selection of leaders. Visitors have limited access to the site, and may not camp at the Summit Bechtel Reserve.
